BUNGLE BUNGLE SCENIC FLIGHT

This 2.5 hour return flight departs directly from the Station following the Bullo River, then over the Pinkerton Range and neighbouring Auvergne Station, giving you a true appreciation of the shape and size of the Station. Fly over the Victoria Highway that goes all the way to Broome, before your flight converges with the southern shoreline of Lake Argyle, the largest manmade lake in the Southern Hemisphere. Take in the Ord River and Bow River Diamond Mine, before descending to a lower 2,500ft for your flight around the Bungle Bungle Range. The Bungle Bungle is the result of 20 million years of weathering which have produced the eroded sandstone towers and banded beehive structures. From the Bungle Bungle, track towards Kununurra passing overhead the Argyle Diamond Mine, which is the world's largest mine. Take in the diversion dam and the many farms and variety of crops that the irrigation scheme supports, before making your way back to the station.

Aircraft: Bullo Cessna 210 Single Engine Aircraft, seats up to 5 passengers - *maximum payload 400kgs***

Q1 - 1 DAY BUNGLE BUNGLES TOUR – CATHEDRAL GORGE & PICCANINNY CREEK

Fly directly from Bullo River Station to Bellburn Airstrip at the Bungle Bungles arriving at 10.00am (WST) where you will be met for your 4WD tour. Transfer by 4WD vehicle along Gorge Track to the southern side of the Bungle Bungle Massif to begin an easy walk into Cathedral Gorge. Arrival into the gorge displays a magnificent amphitheatre designed by nature at its best. Picnic lunch is included on this tour and is enjoyed in the Gorge in a shaded area. After lunch join a guided walk along the ancient dry bed of Piccaninny Creek and inspect the 350-million-year-old orange and black striped beehive domes up close. Your guide will bring the natural history of the Bungle Bungle domes to life. Learn about the Aboriginal people's rich knowledge of the area and the cultural significance of the park. You can even learn bushtucker and bush medicine skills. Following the tour, rejoin the 4WD and return to Bellburn Airstrip at approximately 3.00pm for your return flight to Bullo River Station.

Q3 - 1 DAY BUNGLE BUNGLES TOUR – BEST OF THE BUNGLES IN A DAY

Fly directly from Bullo to Bellburn Airstrip at the Bungle Bungles arriving at 7.00am (WST) where you will be met and transferred to the Bungle Bungle Wilderness Lodge for breakfast. Then journey by 4WD vehicle to the starting point of the walk, Echidna Chasm on the northern side of the range. Hike along the Livistona palm-fringed trail through towering sandstone walls and into the chasm, where you enjoy a picnic lunch. Following lunch, travel to the southern side of the massif and the starting point for the walk into the majestic Cathedral Gorge. Enjoy time exploring the Gorge, marveling at how the sandstone cliffs form a huge natural amphitheatre, before taking an easy-paced walk along the ancient dry bed of Piccaninny Creek and inspect the domes up close. As you walk your guide will bring the history of these unique structures to life, explaining how 20 million years of weathering has produced these eroded sandstone towers and banded beehive structures. Listen as your guide explains the Aboriginal cultural significance of this area and learn of Aboriginal bushtucker and bush medicine skills. Return to the Bellburn Airstrip at approximately 3.00pm for your return flight to Bullo River Station.

- Please note that prices are subject to change with rising fuel costs and factors beyond our control. Booking prior to travel is essential.

- Passengers need to have a good level of fitness. We recommend that passengers wear comfortable walking shoes, light clothing, sunscreen and a hat. They should carry a minimum 1 litre of water. They will be able to refill their water bottle throughout the day. They should carry a light back pack for camera and personal items. Walking in Purnululu National Park is on dry river beds with loose pebble like stones on the ground.
